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MICROPIGMENTATION COSMED.INK

It is normal for the micropigmentation to be darker once the procedure is completed. The color will not be true to the healed color since there is some bleeding during the procedure and that will make the color darker.

For permanent Makeup, 30% to 60% of the color will fade after four (4) or five (5) days. Please schedule your follow up appointment any time after four (4) to six (6) weeks.

For compromised skin tattoo's as: scar tissue, stretched skin/stretch marks, radiated skin, you will lose some of the color. Please ensure that the area is completely healed before you schedule your touch up.

CARE FOLLOWING THE PROCEDURE:

<u>Medications:</u> Take Tylenol for any discomfort. If you have a history do cellulitis, please take antibiotic tablets as directed. Continue to avoid aspirin and ibuprofen products for one (1) week after procedure.

<u>Follow Up:</u> A second procedure is necessary for permanent makeup post four(4) to six (6) weeks to ensure perfection and longevity of definition and color.

<u>Important information</u>: Wash the procedure area with warm water and mild soap. Apply a thin layer of unscented, colorless lotion (coconut oil is a great option) when it feels tight, dry or itchy. Otherwise let it air out and heal naturally. No Vaseline or Polysporin!

Do not pick or scratch off any flacking in pigmented area; you will notice a few layers of flakes skin peeling, this is completely normal.

Do not apply any makeup on the procedure.

Avoid sun and tanning bed for at least seven (7) days.

No strenuous exercise (i.e., gym) during healing process (15 days).
